

## **Community Service Verification Form**

Every Pivot Charter School student is required to participate in 20 hours of community service each semester. Community service may include activities such as working for a soup kitchen, a church or nursing home etc... It may NOT include assisting the student's parent/guardian or anything for which the student receives compensation. The verification of hours must be signed by a staff person or supervisor of the organization with whom the student participated; the form may not be signed by the student's parent/guardian. There are several types of Community Service. They include:

**Direct Community Service** (person-to-person, face-to-face service) such as assisting in a nursing home.

*Indirect Community service* (working on broad issues, advocacy, environmental project, community development) such as a recycling project or a beach clean-up.

**Research-Based Community service** (gathering and presenting information on areas of interest and need) such as presenting information to a group of elementary school students about ecology.

**Advocacy Community service** (educating others about topics of public interest) such as participating in a rally to save our lakes and streams or making posters about the environment and "going green."
